97 Rowlands Avenue: single and two-storey front extension; two-storey side; single and two-storey other side extension; two-storey rear extensions

Grove Corner, Royston Grove: single-storey side extension Greylands, 47 Wellington Road: conversion of dwelling house to seven flats. Alteration of roof to form end gables; two side dormers; first floor rear gable extension with roof terrace; three roof lights to front; four to rear and one to side roof slopes; landscaping, parking (only five spaces) and rear bin compound

53A Wellington Road: single-storey rear extension 28 Cedar Drive: single-storey front extension; two-storey side to rear extension; alterations to form end gables rear and side dormers

Notifications of Intention of Householders Extension (NIHE)

46 The Lawns and 28 Cedar Drive. Both 6m rear extensions. York House, Grimsdyke Road: conversion – offices on ground floor and flats above to a three-storey building. Environment Agency may object as the applicants have not produced an adequate Flood Risk Assessment (FRA).
