Roger Bannister Playing Fields: Creation of an 18 hole golf adventure experience facility including theme props and ancillary kiosk; refuse storage P/0672/18. Most objections are concerning parking in the area

1 Lytton Road: gable roof extension at the rear; at the sides and at the rear two side dormers; external alterations to facilitate loft conversion P/0602/18

Chantry House, Chantry Place: conversion of offices to self-contained flat P/0222/18

54 Wellington Road: tree work to beech tree

37 Tillotson Road: installation of canopy at rear P/0734/18

15 Old Hall Close: three rear dormers to create habitable roof space P/0825/18
